The Lucas County Board of Elections is in need of Seasonal workers, and Precinct Election Officials (P.E.O.) for the November 7, 2017 General Election cycles. Every Election Day, thousands of Ohioans play an important role in our democracy by working for the Board of Elections. These Seasonal and P.E.O.s work hard to ensure that their neighbors can vote with ease, while also helping to safeguard the process so that all Ohioans can have confidence in the results.

P.E.O. time commitment includes a scheduled training class, the Monday evening set-up prior to Election Day, and work to be performed on Election Day, (typically starting at 5:30 a.m. and concluding at 8:30 p.m.) A P.E.O. will be paid a minimum of \$125.00 for training and completion of Election Day work.

Seasonal work time commitment would be approximately through December 1, 2017, dependent on the position and department. Scheduling hours will vary dependent upon duties and department to which you are assigned. Hourly rate varies upon position, with a minimum of \$9.20.

Attention to detail and good organizational skills are needed for all positions. In addition, data entry skills are required for office or Early Vote personnel.

Qualifications: You must be a U. S. citizen, at least 18 years of age and a registered voter in Lucas County. You must not have been convicted of a felony, and you cannot be a candidate for office in the election for which you would be working. Must have reliable transportation.
