### Verifications necessary to determine Childcare program eligibility:

- Proof of Income
- Proof of any child support paid or received
- Proof of citizenship or qualified alien status for children in need of care
- Proof of a qualifying activity for all caretakers in the household (for example: work or school/training)
- Provide the name and address of an eligible Childcare provider for each child in need of care (To find a Childcare Provider in Lucas County and surrounding area visit: <http://childcarenetwork.ohio.gov>)

### Important Updates / Federal Law Change

- From March 2023 through the end of February 2024 Lucas County has waived the interview requirement for individuals **renewing** their **cash and SNAP benefits**. The waiver of the interview is only applicable for cash and SNAP redeterminations.
- Initial applications still require interviews.
- All applications and documents will be processed as normal.
- A completed 7204 must be submitted with verifications for all Income and Expenses. Assistance groups **remain subject to all other reporting requirements** until their recertification.
- Renewals for Medical Assistance **are still required annually** and can be completed by mail, phone or online through the Self-Service Portal.

- LCDJFS will see clients by pre-arranged appointment only in instances where a client has either insufficient technology or inability to navigate our system remotely or the need to make a cash payment on a repayment agreement. *(If a situation arises that requires face-to-face contact, the necessity for such an appointment will be determined by the agency. You must request and schedule such an appointment.)*
