14) Within ten (10) business days of the receipt of this application the County Engineer may determine that the applicant will be required to provide additional information for some or all of the following:

- a) Property map indicating other access, bordering roads and nearby drives.
- b) Proposed access design.
- c) Traffic control plan.
- d) Traffic Impact Study
- e) Sight Distance Study.
- f) Other information as required by the County Engineer.

If this access permit is granted, the applicant agrees to the following conditions (not applicable for preliminary access approval requests):

- i) Traffic will be maintained at all times, unless permission is granted by the County Engineer to close the road.
- ii) Disturbance to all pavement and shoulders/berms will be kept to minimum. Tracked equipment will not be permitted on the roadway. When any pavement or shoulders/berms is damaged either by construction, construction equipment or by excessive weight, Permittee shall make complete restoration as directed by the County Engineer.
- iii) Lights, signs, barricades, and if necessary steel plates, flaggers will be placed on the project site for protection of traffic at all times, day and night. The Permittee shall fully comply with the maintenance of traffic per the Ohio Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices and as directed by the County Engineer's Office.
- iv) Permittee shall assume the responsibility for and will hold the County and Township harmless from any and all claims for personal injuries and/or property damages, and shall defend any action that might be brought due to the applicants' activities on this project and/or under this permit.

If an access permit is issued to you it will state the terms and conditions for its use. The permit status may be reevaluated for any changes in the use of the permitted access not consistent with the terms and conditions listed on the permit.

The applicant declares that all information provided on this form and the submitted attachments, which are made part of the application, are accurate and complete to the best of their knowledge.

Whoever violates any provision of the Access Management Regulations shall be fined not more than **\$500.00** for each offense. Each day of violation is a separate offense.

I hereby agree that said work will be done at my own expense in accordance with the provisions of law and in accordance with the current Lucas County Construction Standards. The final surface should be constructed so that it is graded to

drain and slopes away from the edge of pavement. The size and grade of the conduit having been established by the Lucas County Engineer. **Contact the Lucas County Engineers @ (419) 213-2860, two (2) working days in advance of commencing work under the permit to set up an inspection and then again upon completion of work for a final inspection.**

This permit may at any time be revoked or annulled for non-performance of or noncompliance with any of the said conditions, restrictions and regulations thereof. This permit shall be in the possession of the person in charge of the work and shall be shown on request to any employee of the County Engineer.
