#### Latex Paint

\$1.00 /gallon or under container  
\$5.00/ 5 gallon container

*\*Latex paint is not hazardous.*

*It can be disposed with regular trash, if solidified.*

*Cat litter, sand, saw dust or soil can be used to solidify latex paint. A box lined with a trash bag or partially filled paint cans can hold the solidified material. If paint cans are used, leave lid off so waste hauler can see the paint is dry.*

#### Fluorescent Bulbs

\$1.00/bulb



Leave materials in original container. Tighten caps & lids and pack containers in sturdy, upright boxes & pad with newspaper. Sort & pack separately. NEVER MIX CHEMICALS. Never smoke around or while handling hazardous materials.
