BY ORDER

Parties may be referred to the 2 class seminar through an order from a Judge or Magistrate.

VOLUNTARILY

The parties may ask a Judge or Magistrate during their court proceeding, to attend the 2 class seminar.

Is there a cost?

Cost is \$25 per person and payment is requested to be made within 30 days of the order.

How do I pay?

Payment of cash, check or credit card (fees will apply) can be made in the Clerk of Courts office, located on the first floor, at any time during normal business hours of 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

Where are the classes?

Classes are held at the Lucas County Juvenile Court Training Room.


